## Notes by Jon Becker, editor for the Collins project

In his journal entry of 9 April 1939, Collins penned:

Easter Sunday (Seventy four years ago today Lee surrendered to Grant at Appomattox. It was also a Sunday.) In the morning finished "Didn't My Lord Deliver Daniel.' (The other day I bought an amazing collection of Negro spirituals and am going to make piano pieces of them).

Lil' David Play on Yo' Harp soon followed, while Joshua Fit de Battle ob Jerico, The Gospel Train, and All God's Chillun' Got Wings were completed in the late 1940s.

Collins biographer Erik Eriksson wrote of these five works: "All are imaginative, energetic, and highly developed treatments of straight-forward themes."
